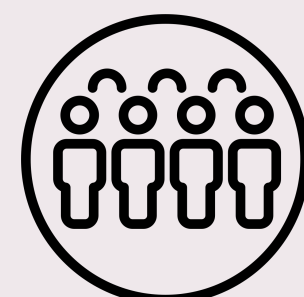

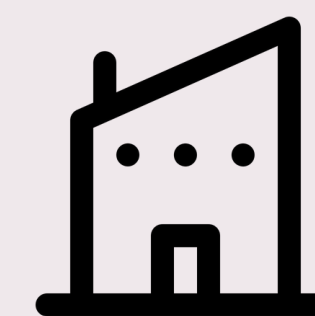

## Employment within the sector (2021)

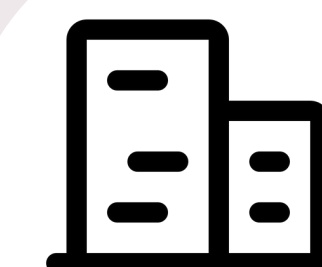

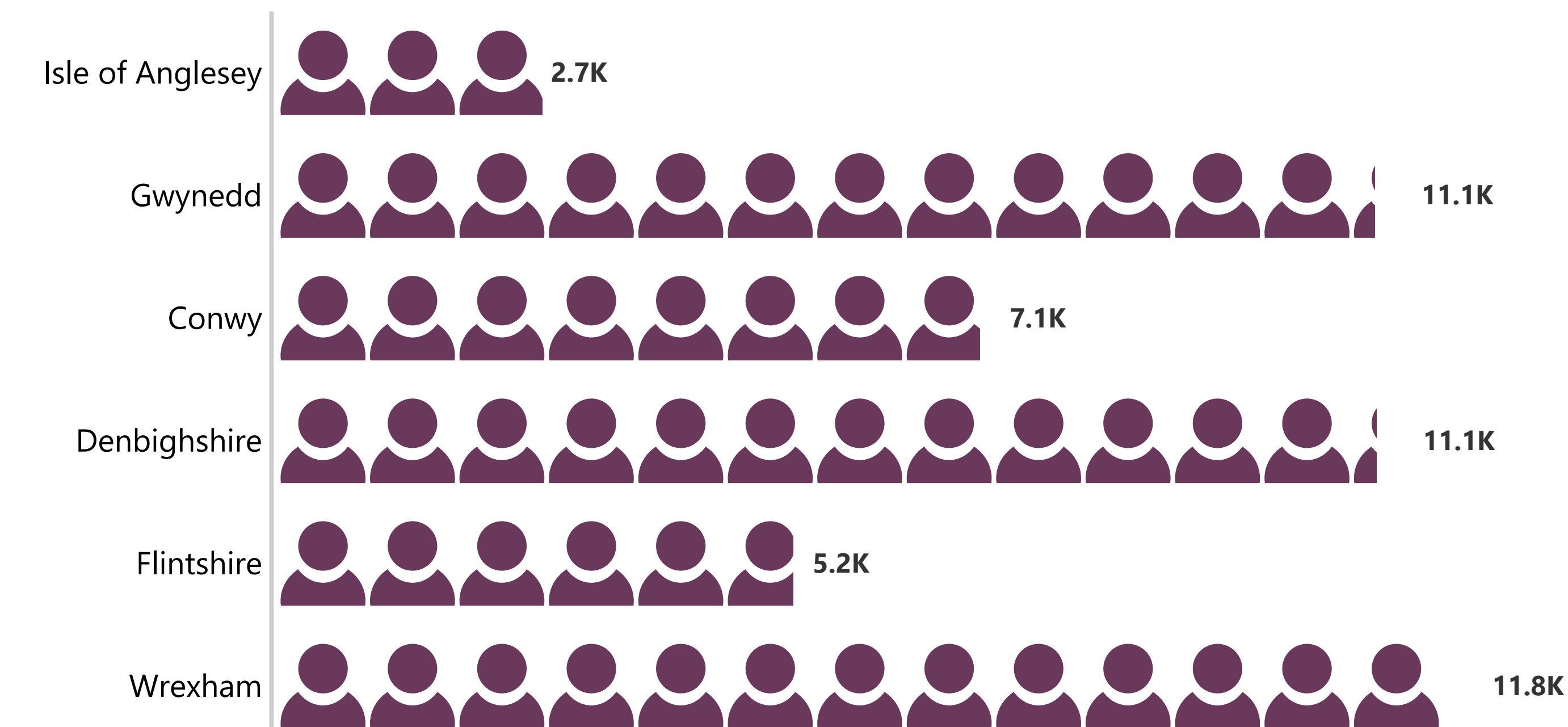

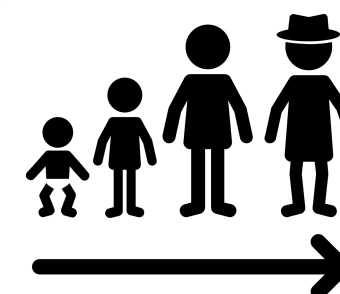

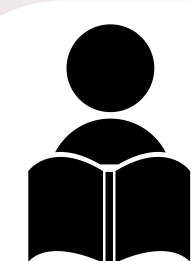
